Covid-19

When parking in Church Car Park please leave one parking space between cars.

When entering the Church be aware of social distancing and use hand sanitiser.

No socialising in the Vestibule. This area must be clear at all times for access and exit only.

Due to restrictions on seating members will not be able to choose their seat but will be asked to accept the seating arrangements that have been provided for their safety and the safety of others.

Church seating arrangements as follows;- First in will go to the front pews and will fill from front to back as directed by Church Stewards.

When leaving the Church the Parishioners next Newry Street in the back pews nearest to the vestibule doors will leave first, maintaining social distancing and using hand sanitiser. This aisle will leave by the main front doors.

The aisle next the graveyard Parishioners in the front pews will exit the building via the emergency doors at the front of the church maintaining social distancing and using hand sanitiser and access Newry Street by the under croft path.

Access to the gallery will be by the first stairs just inside the front door. The same rule will apply to seating. First in will go to the front and use available seating set out to comply with Covid-19 regulations.

When leaving the Gallery be aware of social distancing at the top of the stairs and exit the building down back stairs down to the Vestibule turn right through back doors using sanitiser and the under croft path to Newry Street.

Members of the same household are permitted to use one pew with no social distancing and make best use of available seating on the ground floor. Families can use pews adjacent to the exterior walls and the centre pews in the aisle next Newry Street.

The centre pews in the aisle next back graveyard are available for two from the same household or one individual.

Two from different households can use one pew by sitting at each end of the pew, however two from different households cannot use pews with columns or the centre pews in the next back graveyard.

Side facing pews beside emergency exit door at the front of the Church are available for a maximum of three from the same household or one individual.

Seating in the gallery follows the same principle, families from the same household are free to use one pew or two from different household must maintain social distancing.

Please bring your own bible as all books will be removed from the pews.

Any two on Audio visual duty not from the same household will be required to wear face masks and eye protection.

Photocopy room. A maximum of three are permitted to use this area maintaining social distancing for the purpose of CD Ministry and photocopy requirements.

Toilet facilities at Church Hall entrance, Morrison Room and kitchen area will not be available for use.

Toilet facilities will be available at Vestibule back door ..

Stewards will be on duty so please follow their directions at all times
